

## PENN-OHIO MORGAN HORSE ASSOCIATION HIGH POINT AWARDS SYSTEM RULES

1. Owners and lessees must be current members of the POMHA at the time points are won for the points to count toward yearly awards.
2. All horses must be registered with AMHA or be eligible for registration.
3. Any shows and events which are sponsored, endorsed by, or a member of a recognized association or circuit, incorporated horse club, or 4-H sponsored open horse show will be eligible and qualify for points.
4. Points system to be in effect from December 1 through November 30 of each year.
5. Points remain with the horse when it is bought or sold, providing the new owner is a member of the POMHA.
6. All records shall be audited after they are closed by a committee of POMHA members appointed by the President and approved by the Board of Directors.
7. Horses can be nominated at anytime throughout the show season, but nominations must be filed and a fee of \$5.00 per division must be paid and postmarked prior to any shows or events for points to count. POINTS ARE NOT RETROACTIVE. The fees are to be used toward the awards and expenses of this system.
8. The awards shall be presented at a special awards banquet, date to be announced. Awards will be given to the first five places in each division.
9. Official High Point Results forms are to be provided to members upon request via: Point Secretary, Board of Directors, or at POMHA meetings.
10. Official High Point Results Forms must be completed with correct show information and placings, and postmarked and sent to the point secretary within 31 days of the date of the show. Points are as follows:

Regular classes:

1 <sup>st</sup> .....	10
2 <sup>nd</sup> .....	8
3 <sup>rd</sup> .....	6
4 <sup>th</sup> .....	4
5 <sup>th</sup> -10 <sup>th</sup> .....	2

Championship classes:

1 <sup>st</sup> .....	15
2 <sup>nd</sup> .....	12
3 <sup>rd</sup> .....	9
4 <sup>th</sup> .....	6
5 <sup>th</sup> - 10 <sup>th</sup> .....	3

### NO POINTS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER NOVEMBER 15<sup>TH</sup>

Any shows providing an affiliation fee to POMHA will receive double points (shows to be announced before each show season).

All Morgan, non-Class A shows will receive +4 bonus points.

All Class A shows in the Morgan division will receive +6 bonus points.

All Morgan, Class A shows will receive +10 bonus points, with the exception of Penn-Ohio and Grand Nationals.

The Grand National Show will receive +15 bonus points.

The POMHA Show and Brookfield National will count as triple points +10 bonus points. Bonus points will count toward participation in any class of the POMHA show or Brookfield National.

11. Ties are to be broken by using the horse with the highest number of 1<sup>st</sup> places, 2<sup>nd</sup> places, etc.
